2020 TRAINING SCHEDULE

WHAT IS PITD?

The Pacific International Training Desk is a 4-week training established by the US National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA)/National Weather Service (NWS) at the Weather Forecast Offices (WFO) in Honolulu and Guam. Level-1 training is intended to prepare weather observers to understand the forecast process, learn fundamental concepts and skills required for forecasting, and provide an opportunity for basic hands-on work with meteorological analysis and prediction. The training also covers messaging and weather communications with the use of RANET systems. Level-2 training includes more in-depth materials for junior forecasters. The Pacific Desk will prepare trainees to return to their weather offices for further operational forecasting experience.

HOW TO APPLY?



Trainees are current employees (e.g. non-Scientific Officers, weather observers, meteorological technicians, etc.) or authorized nominees from their respective governments. Nominees are officially nominated by their governments to attend. Submit a completed Registration Form and provide a current CV/Resume. Nominees must be able to obtain a US entry visa and must be able to travel to the US. WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

PITD invites Meteorological and Hydrological Service employees or authorized representatives from Pacific island members of the Regional Association (RA-V) of the World Meteorological Organization with a focus on small developing countries. The program is intended as an early step in initial forecast training. preparing trainees for lengthier and more advanced training programs such as Australia Bureau of Meterology programs and Regional Training Programs/Courses in Japan, the philippines, and elsewhere. Level-1 training is geared towards non-Scientific Officers (observers, met technicians, etc.) with no more than one year of experience in weather forecasting. Level-2 training is offered to junior forecasters.
